Opener

Praise God for his amazing love and grace and mercy.

Praise him for his sovereignty and for having a perfect plan throughout history, His plan of redemption for anyone who sees the need for forgiveness for his sins and who trusts Jesus as his Savior

Praise God for never changing his mind before he came to this world in the form of a human as Jesus and for never changing his mind after.

Praise Jesus for his amazing sacrifice on the cross for us to “save completely those of us who come to God through Him, because He always intercedes for us” (Hebrews 7:25)

Hebrews 7:11-28

Engaging with God in a Group

Have you ever doubted the permanency of your eternal salvation and feared that Jesus might have “changed His mind” about you? How did you react? What passage in God’s Word has assured you of your salvation?

- In what ways does Jesus meet your every need?
- If you are married, share about what the marriage covenant means to you and how the promise to never leave “till death do us part” enriches your relationship and helps you grow in your walk with Jesus and with each other.
- If you are single, share about the wonderful intimacy with Jesus that the New Covenant provides for you.
