Opener

When you think of Moses, do you think first of Charlton Heston or Prince of Egypt?

Read

Exodus 3:1-4:17; Matthew 28:18-20; 2 Corinthians 3:5-6; 1 Corinthians 2:1-5; Romans 10:16-17; 2 Corinthians 12:9-10;

Main Points

- 1. God assured Moses with Divine Presence, Divine Name, Divine Signs, Divine Help, and Divine Community.
- 2. God uses us, not in spite of our weaknesses, but because of our weakness.
- 3. Self-centered reasons begin and end with us.
- 4. God-centered assurances begin with God and ends with others.
- 5. In our pursuit of others, God's assurances count us in when our reasons count us out.

Continuing the Conversation

- How have you typically responded when you sense God leading you to something that seems too big or difficult for you?
- Which reason or reasons do you resonate most with that Moses experience:
 (a) I am not good enough (question of identity), (b) I don't know enough (question of experience), (c) I may fail (fear of failure), (d) I am not capable (question of ability), (e) I am not willing (passing up the opportunity)?
- When have you been convinced of God's ability to do what he invites you into?
- What assurances do you need to be reminded of in your current season of life to step into his pursuit of others through you?
