## **Ice Breaker**

What's your favorite childhood book or movie?

## **Read**

John 9:1-17, 24-38

## **Main Points**

1. We are called to Christ and sent to people.
2. As we live in our identity as sent, we get a front row seat to what Jesus is doing in the lives of those who don't know him yet.
3. The Pharisees were focused on what couldn't be explained, the healed man was focused on what he couldn't deny.
4. Jesus isn't a product we sell, he's a person we introduce.

## **Group Discussion**

- When have you experienced a moment with Jesus that changed how you saw yourself or the circumstances you were in?
- What is a struggle you've had that you've seen the power of God over?
- Who is someone God has used in your life to convince of his love for you?
- What verse or passage from scripture has God used in a meaningful way in your life?

## **Bottom Line**

Stories are powerful, stories of Jesus are enterally powerful.
