Main Points

- 1. 7 Way to Pray
 - a. Ask for revelation. (Ephesians 1:17-19)
 - b. Ask that God "turn their eyes from worthless things." (Psalm 119:34-37)
 - c. Ask that they "come to their senses." (2 Timothy 2:25-26)
 - d. Ask God to send others to help. (Matthew 9:38)
 - e. Ask for an "open door for the message." (Colossians 4:2-4)
 - f. Ask for boldness for you. (Ephesians 6:18-20)
 - g. Ask that God moves quickly. (2 Thessalonians 3:1)
- 2. 4 Mindsets of Loving Conversation
 - a. Be curious
 - b. Believe the best
 - c. Express concern
 - d. Share your life
- 3. Six Conversation Pathways (1) Social, (2) Physical, (3) Emotional, (4) Cognitive,
 - (5) Volitional, (6) Spiritual
