Ice Breaker

Read

Ezekiel 47:1-12; Romans 3:22-25; John 4:14; John 7:37-39; Revelation 22:1-3, 17

Main Points

- 1. The river of life started at the temple, represents the cross of Jesus. It flows east, toward the Dead Sea and brings healing.
- 2. The river of life is flowing through us to the people around us!

Group Discussion

- How have you experienced Jesus bringing his life and healing to your soul through others?
- Who might he be sending you to so that he could flow through you for their encouragement and to find life and healing in him?
- What's your biggest challenge in living sent?
