WHAT YOU NEED: Paper plates, crayons,

green construction paper, scissors, glue sticks, pencil

WHAT YOU DO:

Trace your child's hand on the green construction paper and cut it out, or have child cut it out if able. Color the paper plate blue. Glue paper hand to the center of the plate. Draw a heart in the middle of their hand cutout.

WHAT YOU SAY:

"In our story, we learned that God loves me and you, and everyone in the whole wide world! God loves the world so much that He gave us Jesus to be our friend forever. **Who loves you? God loves me.**"

Key Question: Who loves you? Bottom Line: God loves me.

Story Squares

What You Need: Activity page, crayons, scissors, glue

What You Say & Do: Talk through the story words (John 3:16) while assisting the children in placing their story pictures in the designated spaces.

Before the Activity: "Who loves you? *[Bottom Line]* God loves me! He sure does! I have something fun for us to do to help us remember how much God loves us. We have a page with the story words on it and some story pictures to cut out. Our job is to put all of the pictures in the right place on this page. Do you think we can do it? Sure, we can!"

During the Activity: "Listen as I read and then I want you to tell me what picture you think goes in the first box. Ready? God LOVES. Do you see a picture that looks like love? Yes! The heart! Put your heart picture in the first box. Great! Now, let's think about what picture goes in the second box.

"Listen as I read the Bible verse again. God loves the WORLD. Do you see a picture that looks like a world? Yes! That's the world! Put your world picture in the second box. Looking good! Now, let's think about what picture goes in the third box.

"Listen as I read the Bible words! God loves the world so much He GAVE. Do you see a picture that looks like something you give to someone? Yes! The present! We give presents. Put your present picture in the third box. We're almost done. Now, let's think about what picture goes in the fourth box.

"Listen as I read the story words. God loves the world so much He gave us JESUS! Do you see a picture that looks like Jesus? Yes! That's a picture of Jesus. Put your Jesus picture in the fourth box."

After the Activity: "We did it! Now, you have a great picture of how much God loves you! You can use them to tell everyone that (*point to the squares*) God LOVES the WORLD so much He GAVE us JESUS! Yay! **Who loves you?** [Bottom Line] God loves me!"

Start the Conversation: How do you know God loves you?

(Family Leader: Share your story about how you know Jesus with your child)
