## **Engage with God in a Group**

- What are the things in your life where you would say may hinder you from stopping to see those around you?
- How would your life be impacted if you asked God to show you those around you: to slow down and see, to slow down and listen?
- What changes in our lives if we stop asking “who is my neighbor” and began realizing we *are* a neighbor to whomever Jesus brings along our path?

## **Bottom Line**

Love moves when we draw on him to care for others and the arrow that matters moves outward.
