Opener

What has been the most often utilized method of decision-making in your life when you have a choice to make and aren't sure which option is best for you?

Read

Genesis 1:26-28, 31; Genesis 3:6-7; Romans 5:12; John 3:16; 1 Peter 1:18-19; Romans 1:16; Revelation 5:9-10, 21:3

Engage with God in a Group

- When you think about the major issues in our culture, how would you describe your mindset?
- How often would you describe your way of thinking as biblically sound, theologically accurate, and loving?

- Which relationships do you have that would be healthier if we realized that "people aren't the problem, people are the goal"?
