John 13:34-35; John 17:20-12, 23; Leviticus 19:18; Matthew 22:37-38; Matthew 5:43-44; John 13:2-5; Philippians 2:7-8; Romans 5:8; John 13:12-15

Engage with God in a Group

- How is Jesus' love different from any other?
- What barriers do you have in your own thoughts to fully embracing the truth that Jesus loves you with his perfect, unconditional, selfless, overwhelming love?
- Why do you think Jesus gave this new command to love one another as he has loved us and what makes it so new?
- How would our interactions with others change if we loved others as Jesus has loved us?
