Opener

What are your thoughts about moving towards two in-person services on September 12th? What do you think you're going to do when that date comes?

Read

Matthew 16:13-19; Revelation 5:9-10;

Main Points

1. Goals for September 12th, when we go to two in-person services (9:00 & 11:00): (a) 500 more people back in our in-person services, (b) 150 new servant leaders, (c) Bent Tree online digitally engaged and relationally connected.
2. Movements come and go, except for the movement that is the Church of Jesus! It began before the world was formed and will go on for eternity.
3. The Church is God's move. The Church is God's move for you. The Church is God's move through you.
4. Jesus is building his Church, and he's doing it through ordinary people experiencing and sharing his extraordinary love.

Engage with God in a Group

- Which movement in history has grabbed your attention the most? What is it about that movement that is of particular interest to you?
- Have you ever joined a movement? What was your experience in it?
- What does it mean to you that we are the move of God...we are his movement in this world that will never end?
- Who do you think God has put in your life to reach through you? Would you ask him this week, "who are you reaching through me" as you begin each day?

Bottom Line

We are not waiting on a move of God, we ARE the move of God.
