Opener

Are you most energized by being around people or by having time alone?

Read

Matthew 16:13-19; Matthew 16:24-26

Main Points

1. Jesus calls his followers to pursue the unlikeliest of people.
2. Pursuing people is not a pressure to carry, but a privilege to enjoy because the Father is already drawing them to himself.
3. Pursuing people with the good news of Jesus is most important and most urgent.
