Opener

What burdens you the most about your town, neighborhood, or community?

Read

Matthew 16:13-21; Romans 6:8-9; John 11:25; Rev 1:17b-18; Matthew 17:1-9; 2 Cor 3:18

Main Points

1. Jesus has already won us the victory so we don't fight *for* victory, we fight *from* victory.
2. In and through the power of the resurrection, the Church of Jesus will not be vanquished by death.
3. The glory of Jesus for us is not limited to a rare mountain experience. Everyday, through the Holy Spirit, we get to behold the glory of Jesus and God moves us down the mountain into brokenness and hopelessness.
