## **Opener**

What do you remember about how it felt when you got your first set of keys - to a car, home, or at work?

## **Read**

Matthew 16:13-19; Revelation 1:8; Matthew 18:19-20; John 14:13; John 3:3; Romans 10:9-10; Acts 2:36; Acts 10:44-48; Acts 10:34; Acts 17:16-27; Mark 11:17;

## **Main Points**

1. God has called us to (1) Pursue Our Community (Pray. Care. Share), (2) Transform Our Community (Hunger, Homelessness, Human-Trafficking), and (3) Reflect Our Community (Pray and Posture).
2. Jesus has given the “keys to the Kingdom of Heaven” to all who believe. This gives believers *authority* and *access* - *authority* by which they could provide *access* to people all over the world to approach the King of kings.
3. Pray that Bent Tree would reflect our region. Get to know someone different than you.

## **Engage with God in a Group**

- How do we operate differently when we know we have authority and access?
- Where has God been stirring in your soul that burdens you for those in need around you?
- What goes through your mind when you think about intentionally building relationships with those around you who are different than you?
- Spend time in prayer, asking God to grow Bent Tree in reflecting our region.
