Sermon Questions for 12.12.2021*

Opener

When have you been given good news and why was it good? How did it impact the decisions you needed to make?

Read

Isaiah 9:6; Hebrews 2:14-15; 1 Timothy 2:5; Galatians 4:4; John 1:14; Psalm 32:8; Jeremiah 29:11; Colossians 2:3; Romans 8:33-36; 1 Corinthians 1:29-30

Main Points

1. Isaiah describes this child to be born as both God and human. The word “child” describes the humanity of Jesus and the word “Son” describes his divinity.
2. Jesus never became God because he always was God.
3. Jesus is the Wonderful Counselor. “Wonderful” points to Jesus’ glory and “Counselor” points to his nearness.
4. Jesus knows everything about you and he loves you. Some people will love you until they get to know you, but he knows you fully and loves you fully.

Engage with God in a Group

- What is a little advice you were given that has continued to impact your life today? How gave you that advice and why did you embrace it?
- When have you personally experienced Jesus as your “Wonder Counselor”?
- Do you find it easy or difficult to trust Jesus in your decisions? What factors have contributed to how you trust Jesus?
- What is an area of your life in which you need clarity? Take some time to pray together, asking God for clarity.
