December 12 – 4 PM

All journeys announced. Mandatory meeting for students, parents, and leaders.

February 7 – Midnight: Mission journey applications due.

February 11 – 5 PM: Mission journey teams announced.

TBA – 9:30 AM – 2:30 PM: Mission journey leader training.

March 27 – Team Meeting #1: Students/Parents (1-3 MSM and 3-5 HSM)

First half of meeting will include parents and will consist of introductions and trip overview. Second half of meeting, the parents will leave, and the team will do some icebreakers and/or team building activities to get to know each other.

April 24 – Team Meeting #2 (1-3 MSM and 3-5 HSM)

Ken will share material from [When Helping Hurts](#) and Luke Hays will train students and leaders on how to share the Gospel with the colored bracelets. After each teaching, teams will circle up and have discussion around the teaching.

April 27 – Leader Meeting

Also, during this time, the team and parents will gather and spend some time praying (this will take the place of Mission Festivus).
