Opener

What would you consider your most courageous moment so far?

Read

Ruth 1:16-17; Ruth 2; 2 Corinthians 1:3-5

Main Points

- 1. In Ruth 2:2, gleaning isn't a glamorized thing. Ruth put herself at risk as one of the lowest members of society at the time a woman, a widow, barren, an outsider, and poor.
- 2. Ruth ending up in Boaz's field wasn't chance, it was the invisible hand of God directing her to what he had for her.
- 3. God uses Ruth's courage to call Boaz to generosity and to comfort Naomi in her pain.

Engage with God in a Group

- When was a time you saw someone act in a courageous way?
- How have you experienced God's comfort in the midst of pain in your life?
- Are you in a season of pain right now? What area(s) are you experiencing pain/suffering/uncertainty?
- How would you describe God's comfort for you today?
- Where is God calling you to generosity?
- Do you feel courage growing within?
- Who might God want to extend comfort to through how he's comforted you?

Bottom Line

When we have been comforted in Christ, he comforts others in the midst our pain.
