Opener

When did you first put your faith in Jesus as your Savior?

Read

Ruth 4; Matthew 13:44; Matthew 1:3-6, 16

Main Points

- To be a kinsman redeemer, you had to meet three qualifications: (1) relative (right),
 (2) resources (ability), and (3) resolve (willing).
- 2. God provided food in chapter 1, and in chapter 4, God opened Ruth's womb and grants her conception. In the same way, for all of our deepest needs, it is God and God alone who provides. God brings his people from death to life, curse to blessing, bitterness to joy, emptiness to fullness.
- 3. If you are in Christ, Ruth tells us not just what God can do, but what he already has done.
- 4. As Boaz and Ruth took courageous steps in obedience to God, they were paving the way for the Messiah to come.

- In what areas of your life would you recognize that you are the right person, with the ability and willingness to step in by faith?
- Who has God put in your life to share his life and love through you to them?
- What does courageous obedience look like in your life?
