

# Palm Sunday

## Opener

What have you typically done during Holy Week to prepare for Easter?

## Read

John 12:12-21; Revelation 7:9-10; Genesis 3:15; Isaiah 50:6-7; Zechariah 9:9-10b; Psalm 24:7; Exodus 12; John 1:34; 1 Peter 1:18-19; John 3:16

## Main Points

1. Jesus always has the mission of redemption and restoration in view.
2. Jesus knew his arrival through the eastern gates of Jerusalem meant his departure on an old, rugged cross a few days later.
3. Jesus sees Palm Sunday as the appointed time to enter Jerusalem as King.
4. He's Prince bringing peace, the Sovereign offering salvation, and the Ruler ruling in righteousness.
5. He's also the Lamb - chosen, proven, and given.

## Engage with God in a Group

- How did this message change how you understood what took place on Palm Sunday as Jesus entered Jerusalem?
- What are the places in your life where you struggle to recognize Jesus' full authority over you?
- Why is it critical to realize Jesus, as the Lamb, as our final atonement?
- How would your life look different when you appropriate the full authority and final atonement of Jesus?
- Who do you think God is inviting you to share the Good News of Jesus' authority and atonement?

## Bottom Line

Jesus is the King entering on a donkey, and the Lamb on the cross - the one who has full authority and is our final atonement.
