Genesis 1:1, Genesis 2:1-2; John 5:17; Genesis 1:26-28; Genesis 2:15

Main Points

- 1. Work is whichever form in which you find yourself useful.
- 2. We don't go to church, we are the church.
- 3. Your work, whether paid or unpaid, is how God's Kingdom comes and how his will is done.
- 4. The Bible describes God's creation of the world as God's work. He not only works, but he delighted in his works,
- 5. Work is not a necessary evil but is a good necessity. Every Christian is equally called to Christ and to his mission to cultivate a Kingdom culture wherever we are.
- 6. In God's economy, every work has equal dignity and every worker has equal value.
