Genesis 1:1, Genesis 2:1-2; John 5:17; Genesis 1:26-28; Genesis 2:15

Main Points

1. Work is whichever form in which you find yourself useful.
2. We don't go to church, we are the church.
3. Your work, whether paid or unpaid, is how God's Kingdom comes and how his will is done.
4. The Bible describes God's creation of the world as God's work. He not only works, but he delighted in his works,
5. Work is not a necessary evil but is a good necessity. Every Christian is equally called to Christ and to his mission to cultivate a Kingdom culture wherever we are.
6. In God's economy, every work has equal dignity and every worker has equal value.
