Read

1 Corinthians 7:17, 1 John 5:14-15, Romans 13:8-10

Main Points

- 1. There are 6 categories that all of our work fits into:
 - God's Redemptive Work this work is about how God saves and reconciles people.
 - God's Creative Work this work is how God, through creativity, fashions the physical world.
 - God's Providential Work this work is how God provides for and sustains human beings and all of creation.
 - God's Justice Work this work is how God maintains justice in the world.
 - God's Compassion Work this is God's work to comfort, to heal, to guide and shepherd people.
 - God's Revelatory Work this is God's work to enlighten people with truth.
- 2. We don't work for God, we work with him.
- 3. He sends us out, as agents of hope.
