Opener

What is something you wish you had known when you first started working?

Read

1 Corinthians 7:17, 1 John 5:14-15, Romans 13:8-10

Main Points

1. There are 6 categories that all of our work fits into:
 - God's Redemptive Work - this work is about how God saves and reconciles people.
 - God's Creative Work - this work is how God, through creativity, fashions the physical world.
 - God's Providential Work - this work is how God provides for and sustains human beings and all of creation.
 - God's Justice Work - this work is how God maintains justice in the world.
 - God's Compassion Work - this is God's work to comfort, to heal, to guide and shepherd people.
 - God's Revelatory Work - this is God's work to enlighten people with truth.
2. We don't work for God, we work with him.
3. He sends us out, as agents of hope.
