Sermon Questions for 6.19.2022

Opener

What do you think: did Jesus know all the scriptures from birth, or did he have to learn them?

Read

Philippians 2:6-7; Luke 2:40, 45-48, 51-52; John 5:39; 13, 8:3; John 8:17-18; John 10:35; John 6:63; 1 Thessalonians 2:13; Psalm 119:11, 14, 18

Main Points

1. We cannot live in the rhythm of Jesus apart from loving, meditating, and internalizing the scriptures.
2. Jesus in the scriptures: he quoted the Old Testament 78 times from 27 of the Old Testament books.
 - When tempted - Matthew 4:1-11 (Deuteronomy 6:16, 13, 8:3)
 - When accused - John 8:17-18 (Deuteronomy 17:6; Numbers 35:30)
 - When revealing - Luke 4:18-19 (Isaiah 61:1-2); Matthew 5:21, 27 (Exodus 20:13-14); Matthew 21:16 (Psalm 8:2); Luke 19:46 (Isaiah 56:7)
 - When questioned - Matthew 19:4, 6 (Genesis 1:27, 5:2, and 2:24)
 - On the cross - Matthew 27:46 (Psalm 22:1); Luke 23:46 (Psalm 31:5)
3. We recognize God's voice through God's Word.

- What is your biggest question in regards to the scriptures?
