Opener

What is an experience you've had that you couldn't wait to share with others?

Read

Genesis 12:1-3; Genesis 13:16; Revelation 7:9-10; Luke 2:10-11; Exodus 12:38; Leviticus 19:34; Acts 10:34-35, 47; Acts 11:19-21, 26

Main Points

- 1. Somewhere on the timeline of history between Genesis and Revelation, don't give up in the middle because the end of the story will be better than the beginning.
- 2. There's a bookend in Genesis that is also in Revelation the gospel is Good News to all!
- 3. Abraham's faith was that he believed in what God said even when what he saw was contrary to what God said.
- 4. This scene in Revelation embodies the diversity and unity that God longs for his bride, the Church.
- 5. The gospel is good news of great joy to all people because Jesus is good news of great joy to all the people.
- It is no coincidence that in the setting of diversity and unity, in this church marked by unconditional love for one another, that the word Christian is first used. (Acts 11:26)
