Luke 2:8-20; Philippians 2:6-11; 2 Corinthians 4:7

Engage with God in a Group

- In thinking of how God chose to breakthrough through the lowly in the world's eyes how might you be encouraged in your current season of life?
- When have you experienced his breakthrough during a breakdown?
- Read the first verse of *Hark the Harold Angels Sing* together. When you're struggling or experiencing difficulties, how might God want to show you his peace through this verse?

Bottom Line

Breakdown is a prequel to a breakthrough.
