Engage with God in a Group

- In times of distress, do you find it difficult to remember that God is with us or do you cling to him? Why do you think you typically respond that way first?
- How does the Incarnation of the Son of God shift the conversation from “God is absent” to “God has stepped into my hardship”?
- Where in your life is the Spirit inviting you to believe that God is present — what circumstance, what relationship, what aspect of your soul?
